# Chief Easop:

- Jacob Patane would like a letter to be allowed to join the Purchase Mutual Aid Program. After a brief discussion Board was in favor providing he meets his 50 points and does not use his issued equipment.

#### Assistant Chief Graham:

- RedNMx will be changing its name back to RedAlert. Spoke with them about the issues and they said that going forward they will notify us in advance if they are changing anything. They have assigned a tech to fix our run numbers with the county.
- Gave a list of the KnoxBox to Joe DeNisco and he will start reprograming them in the coming weeks.
- Working on the radio surplus list
- Passenger Rescue has been completed and have instructed everyone to give us a copy of their certificates so we can record them in RedNMx
- Need to order replacement AED's as we found out that they are fully automatic.

# VIII. Old Business:

- A motion was made by Commissioner Shovlin and seconded by Commissioner Donnelly to Award the Siding replacement bid for Station 3 to Tam Enterprises in the amount of \$54,862.00. A roll call vote was taken. Commissioners Pearson, Shovlin and Donnelly voted yes. Commissioners Turi and Gallo were absent. Motion passed.
- A motion was made by Commissioner Shovlin and seconded by Commissioner Donnelly to Award the Plumbing bid (As needed) to Joe Lombardo Plumbing & Heating at the following rates:

 A motion was made by Commissioner Shovlin and seconded by Commissioner Donnelly to Award the Networking/VOIP bid to Department of Information Technologies, Inc. DBA TCG Solutions as follows:

IT Support \$150.00/hour

After a discussion the Board agreed to the following proposal with regards to the Minisink
Hook & Ladder ice-machine request. The Board of Commissioner will contribute \$2,500.00
toward the replacement of the ice-machine(the cost to replace with the same model they
currently have). If the Minisink Hook & Ladder company wants the more expensive machine
they will pay the balance. A letter will be sent to them with this proposal.

- A motion was made by Commissioner Shovlin and seconded by Commissioner Donnelly to Allow 932 to attend the county parade on September 27, 2025. A roll call vote was taken. Commissioners Pearson, Shovlin and Donnelly voted yes. Commissioners Turi and Gallo were absent. Motion passed.
- A motion was made by Commissioner Shovlin and seconded by Commissioner Donnelly to Replace all 11 AED's. A roll call vote was taken. Commissioners Pearson, Shovlin and Donnelly voted yes. Commissioners Turi and Gallo were absent. Motion passed.
- Upon a motion made by Commissioner Donnelly and seconded by Commissioner Shovlin a resolution was made to purchase a new UTV and necessary equipment and 5 AED's in the amount of \$52,500 from equipment capital fund following permissive referendum. (Attachment A). A roll call vote was taken. Commissioners Pearson, Shovlin, Donnelly and Gallo voted yes. Commissioner Turi was absent. Motion passed.
- A motion was made by Commissioner Donnelly and seconded by Commissioner Shovlin to Allow the Rotary club to use Station 2 for the race on July 3, 2025. A roll call vote was taken. Commissioners Pearson, Shovlin and Donnelly voted yes. Commissioners Turi and Gallo were absent. Motion passed.

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- A motion was made by Commissioner Donnelly and seconded by Commissioner Shovlin to Allow the Orange County to use Station3 for the Stop dwi /dss car seat installation on July 17, 2025. A roll call vote was taken. Commissioners Pearson, Shovlin and Donnelly voted yes. Commissioners Turi and Gallo were absent. Motion passed.
- Commissioner Donnelly is obtaining a quote from Billco for the removal of the dead trees at Station 3. He is also working on cleaning estimates.
- Secretary Roberts was instructed to contact John Bach with regards to Greenlight putting our name on a flyer stating we are in partnership with them.

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# RESOLUTION OF THE GOSHEN FIRE DISTRICT

Whereas, the district has a need to purchase a new UTV;

Whereas, sufficient reserve funds have been saved in a capital reserve fund which may be utilized to purchase the apparatus and equipment;

Whereas, spending funds in a capital reserve requires the resolution to be subject to permissive referendum;

NOW THEREFORE, upon motion made, seconded and discussion held, and **subject to permissive referendum**, the fire commissioners of the fire district RESOLVE as follows:

- 1. There is hereby declared a need to purchase a UTV and 5 AED's utilizing funds from an appropriate capital reserve fund;
- 2. The district shall purchase the apparatus/equipment utilizing funds from the capital reserve fund;
- 3. Up to \$52,500.00 may be withdrawn from the capital reserve fund for the payment of a UTV and appropriate equipment and 5 AED's. The withdrawal may be taken in one or more amounts;
- 4. No funds may be withdrawn until the passage of thirty days from the date of publication of the abstract of the publication of this resolution;
- 5. The secretary is hereby directed to place an abstract of the resolution upon the town's sign board and website immediately, and must remain there for at least 15 days;
- 6. The secretary is hereby directed to place such abstract in the newspaper having general circulation in this district.

This resolution was approved by a majority of the Commissioners, on the 19th day of June 2025.
